1.	A X C	Enter working trot in pairs. Halt, fan formation, salute. Proceed working trot, in pairs. Divide (1's track right, 2's track left).
2.	MXK HXF	Change rein and thread the needle, 1's in front of 2's
3.	A F-M KXM M	Cross-over. 1's down long side. 2's change rein. Form single file (1's in front of 2's).
4.	Between C & H E	Develop canter, left lead Circle left, 20 meters.
5.	E Between A & F M C	Straight ahead. Working trot. Form pairs in corner. Turn on centerline.
6.	Center on X A	Individual left and right obliques. Turn on centerline in single file.
7.	After D	Individual left oblique.
8.	Between C & M B	Develop canter, right lead. Circle right 20 meters.
9.	Between F & A Between K & H Between F & M	Trot. Individual right turn. Individual left turn.

5.	B & E E & B	When centered on long sides, individual left and right turns; pass through on centerline. Individual right and left turns onto long sides— all heading toward A.
6.	A D-M & D-H C	Turn down centerline, 1's before 2's. Leg yield, alternately right & left. Cross-over.
7.	E & B Before C	Columns half circle to centerline to form pairs. Walk.
8.	C E-X X-B	Pairs turn left. Pairs half circle left onto centerline. Pairs half circle right onto long side.

1.	A X C	Enter working trot in pairs. Halt, fan formation, salute. Proceed working trot, in pairs. First pair track right, second pair track left.
2.	B & E B & E	20 meter circle left and right in pairs, crossing through on centerline. Pairs straight ahead.
3.	F & K A D-M & D-H	Inside horses turn onto centerline. Outside horses turn onto centerline. Leg yield.
4.	C Before B & E	Cross-over. 2nd horse in each file 1/2 circle onto centerline. Forming pairs (heading toward C). 1st horse in each file continue on long sides.
5.	C A K,H,M,F	Pairs divide. Cross-over. Oblique from the corners to the centerline.
6.	Centered on X	Individual 10 meter circles forming a cloverleaf. Upon returning to centerline, form pairs and walk.
7.	X A & C K & H	Pass through. Pairs turn toward K & H, forming single file in corners. Files trot.
8.	Centered on E	Individual right and left turns across the arena.
9.	Centered on B	Track left and immediately individual half circles onto centerline.
