Class 1 and 2 (Intro A and B) = Same horse and rider combination cannot show in Training Level or above.

Class 3 (Intro C) = Same horse and rider combination cannot show above Training Level Test 1.

Class 7 = "Riders competing in Para-equestrian classes must have a permanent physical disability that is measurable by USPEA classification standards." (Official classification is not needed for schooling shows.)

Class 8 (Musical Freestyle) = Does not count for show high point awards. DOES count for year end awards. Please provide copy of qualifying test with your entry (see SMDA's show policies for more info)

Class 14 (Schooling on Grounds) = Not allowed to compete in any tests or ride in the show ring.

AWARDS: 6 ribbons awarded. High score junior and senior champion ribbons.

ENTRIES: Complete entries including all required paperwork are processed in the order they are received. See our show policies for processing entries on our website www.southernmainedressage.com. Show management reserves the right to combine, divide, or cancel any classes as entries warrant. Once the show is filled, entries are placed on a waiting list. Entries received before opening date will be returned. No refunds after the closing date, except for wait list entries not scheduled. Make checks payable to SMDA (Southern Maine Dressage Association) and mail to the show Secretary. There is a \$20 non-negotiable check fee charged for any checks that do not clear. Fee per test is \$25, plus \$3 non-member fee per show if not an SMDA member, and \$1 number deposit per horse/rider combination. Post entries and changes accepted at the discretion of the Secretary with \$3 administration fee for each change. Schooling on grounds fee is \$15 with complete entry form, coggins, and proof of annual rabies vaccine. Please enclose proof of annual rabies vaccine and negative coggins test within 12 months for in-state horses and within 6 months for out-of-state horses (from the date of the show). USDF and USEF rules and regulations are followed. Three or more juniors in a class might be pinned as a separate class at management's discretion. See SMDA omnibus ad page and show policies for year-end award requirements.

TIMES: All efforts are made to post times on the SMDA website at www.southernmainedressage.com Thursday prior to the show date.

Times are also available by calling the Secretary on Thursday before the show date, between the hours of 6PM and 9PM.

STABLING: Not available.

DIRECTIONS: **From I-95:** From Exit 32 Biddeford, take Route 111W to Route 35 and turn right onto Rt. 35. At the junction with Rt. 5, turn left onto Rt. 5. Proceed approximately 2.3 miles. Show grounds are on the left. **From 202 North:** Bar Mills/Hollis Center and up; proceed south on Rt. 202. At the junction with Rt. 5, turn left. Show grounds are on the right approximately 0.9 miles.

From 202 South: Waterboro/Alfred and down, proceed north on Rt. 202. Rt. 202/4 joins Rt. 5. Continue along Rt. 202/4/5. After approximately 1.8 miles, Rt. 5 leaves 202/4. Follow Rt. 5, show grounds are on the right approximately 0.9 miles.

FOOTING: One large sand arena and one small sand warm-up arena. Intro and Training Level classes typically held in small arena.

Musical Freestyle classes are held in large arena.

FOOD: For our 2012 show season, SMDA will NOT have a food vendor. Bottled water will be available for sale. Bring your own food, or there are convenience-type stores available within 2-3 miles of the show grounds.

OTHER: No dogs allowed on grounds the day of the show.
