Class 8, 9 = Does not count for show high point awards. DOES count for year end awards. See information on qualifying for freestyle class on SMDA ad page.

Class 16 = Not competing in other tests or riding in the ring.

AWARDS: 6 ribbons awarded. High score junior and senior champion ribbons.

ENTRIES: Complete entries will be limited and processed in the order they are postmarked. See instructions on our website www.southernmainedressage.com for details on our show policies. No telephone entries please. Show management reserves the right to combine, divide or cancel any classes as entries warrant. Once the show is filled, entries will be placed on a waiting list. Entries postmarked before opening date will not be considered until after closing date. No refunds after the closing date, except for wait list entries not scheduled. Make checks payable to SMDA (Southern Maine Dressage Association) and mail to secretary. There will be a \$20 non-negotiable check fee charged for any checks that do not clear. Fee per dressage class \$20, plus \$3 non-member fee per show if not an SMDA member, and \$1 number deposit per horse/rider combination. Dressage Equitation \$10 per class. Post entries and changes accepted at the discretion of the secretary with \$3 administration fee for each change. Class 16 fee is \$10 with completed entry form, coggins, etc. Please enclose proof of annual rabies vaccine and negative coggins test within 12 months for in-state and within 6 months for out of state (from the date of the show). USDF and USEF rules and regulations will be followed. Three or more juniors in a class may be pinned as a separate class at management's discretion. See SMDA ad page for year-end award requirements.

TIMES: All efforts will be made to post times on the SMDA website at www.southernmainedressage.com by Thursday prior to the show date. Times will also be available by calling the secretary Thursday before the show, between the hours of 6PM and 9PM.

STABLING: Not available.

DIRECTIONS: **From I-95:** From Exit 32 Biddeford, take Route 111W to Route 35 and turn right onto Rt. 35. At the junction with Rt. 5, turn left onto Rt. 5. Proceed approximately 2.3 miles. Show grounds will be on the left. **From 202 North:** Bar Mills/Hollis Center and up; proceed south on Rt. 202. At the junction with Rt. 5, turn left. Show grounds are on the right approximately 0.9 miles. **From 202 South:** Waterboro/Alfred and down, proceed north on Rt. 202. Rt. 202/4 joins Rt. 5. Continue along Rt. 202/4/5. After approximately 1.8 miles, Rt. 5 leaves 202/4. Follow Rt. 5, show grounds are on the right approximately 0.9 miles.

FOOTING: One large sand arena and one small sand warm-up arena. Intro and Training Level classes may be held in small arena.

Musical Freestyle, Quadrille and Pas De Deux to be shown in large arena.

FOOD: Available on grounds.

OTHER: No dogs allowed on grounds the day of the show.
